

I have been averaging over 1200 miles a year in my wheelchair.

## **Accessible**

To make it accessible is to make it approachable by anybody with a disability. They may have a physical, visual or auditory disability.

## **Adaptable**

Visitability is to ensure that all people who use a wheelchair are able to visit their family and friends in their homes. Is the threshold at the entrance door accessible? Are all the hallways and doorways wide enough? Is there access to the bathroom on the main floor?

## **Universal**

Universal design means designing a house to meet the needs of a variety of people and to be able to adapt the house as needed throughout the life of the people that live in them. It will increase safety, be more economical to adapt, provide a chance for people to remain in their home longer, allow people with disabilities to visit, help people who have a degenerative ailment to stay in the community and live in their home.

If you have a degenerative disease where you may end up in a wheelchair the universal house is ideal for you. You can change it as you need it. If you or a family member or have friends that are in a wheelchair, universal housing is a great idea. Also Universal housing lets you live in your house and retire there.
